

An Explanation of Bio Energy Transfer (imprinting)

Imprinting is the process of transmitting a selected signal or signals through a substance. Each signal is transmitted by radio frequency generated by a Computerized Electro Dermal Screening (CEDs) device. Each signal is a digital pattern that stimulated the energy of the homeopathic substance.

The purpose of imprinting is to transfer energy into a substance. The substance can be any liquid, solid, or gas, though a liquid is commonly used. The process of a signal passing through a substance is called transduction. A basic conceptual explanation of transduction is that some of the signal resonates (vibrates) with a substance and then the substance retains the resonant signal for a period of time.

An imprinted substance can simulate the balancing action of a homeopathic energy for a period of time. The imprinted substance has no chemical action.

The period of time for any imprinted substance depends on the length of time for transduction, the type of container, the type of substance and the proper transportation and storage of the substance.

Transduction should take 1-4 minutes and is dependent on the quantity of substances involved.

In 2002, the United States patents office ruled that the process of imprinting for the purpose of simulating a homeopathic is in the public domain. The United States Food and Drug Administration (UDFDA) has no evaluated imprinting or the actions of any homeopathic. Imprinting is not intended to diagnose, treat, cure or prevent any disease. Imprinting is intended to simulate a homeopathic. A homeopathic is intended to transduce the body with energy to balance body energy.
